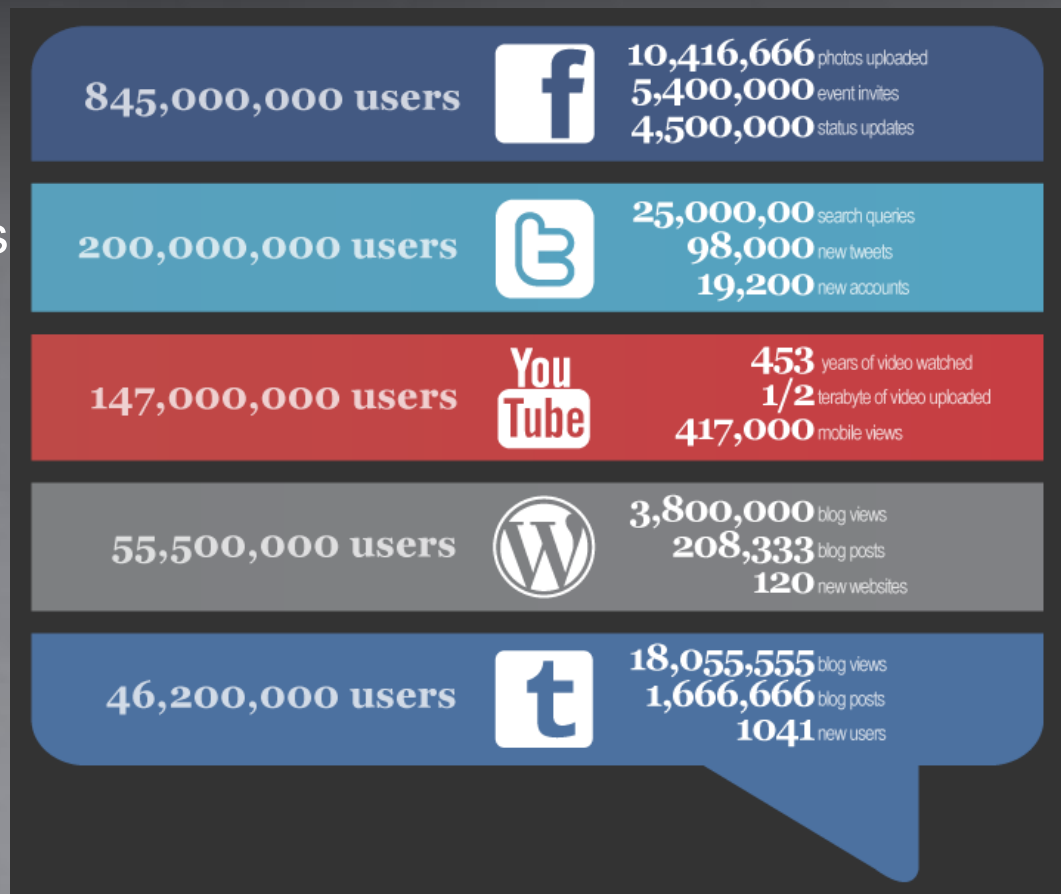

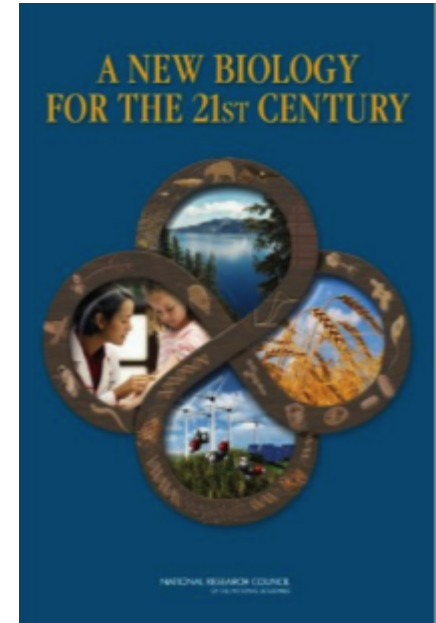

Social Media Characteristics, Premise and Goals

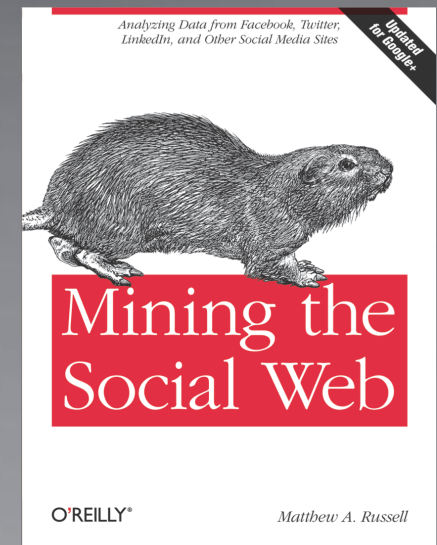
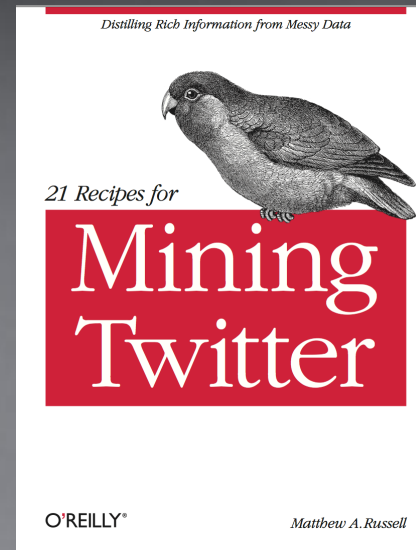
- ▶ Low cost drives volume up and value down
- ▶ Noise generated by spam bots
- ▶ Propagation of signals
 - Driven by perceived importance (subjective)
 - Amplified by visibility
- ▶ Different time scales have different meaning
 - Temporal aggregation → Minutes, hours, days, months
- ▶ Variability in usage
 - Country, domain, culture impacts use
- ▶ Social media platforms as global sensor network
 - Information propagates into and from social media
- ▶ Information emitted by individuals
 - located in time and space & motivated by interests
 - connected through common characteristics
- ▶ Augment public health analyst with computational methods
 - Interaction speed on high volume data with appropriate



How to Get Started with Twitter Data

- ▶ Use the Twitter Search API
 - Superb Learning Resources
 - GitHub
 - O'Reilly
 - <http://dev.twitter.com>
 - limited to 1% random sample

- ▶ Data Provider
 - Expensive
 - \$0.10 / 1,000 tweets
 - ~\$8,000 / month for 10% random sample
 - Requires Substantial Computational Infrastructure



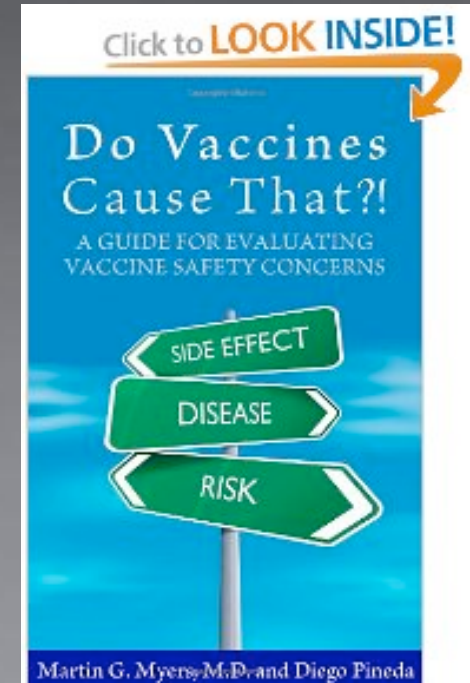
Immunization Safety Beliefs

► Motivation:

- Because search engines only identify topics and list relevant Web sites, the identified information may or may not be reliable. As a consequence, parents with concerns about vaccine safety are as likely to locate misinformation as they are accurate information.
- In social media, they have the opportunity to express their concerns and discuss their findings whether they are informed or misinformed.

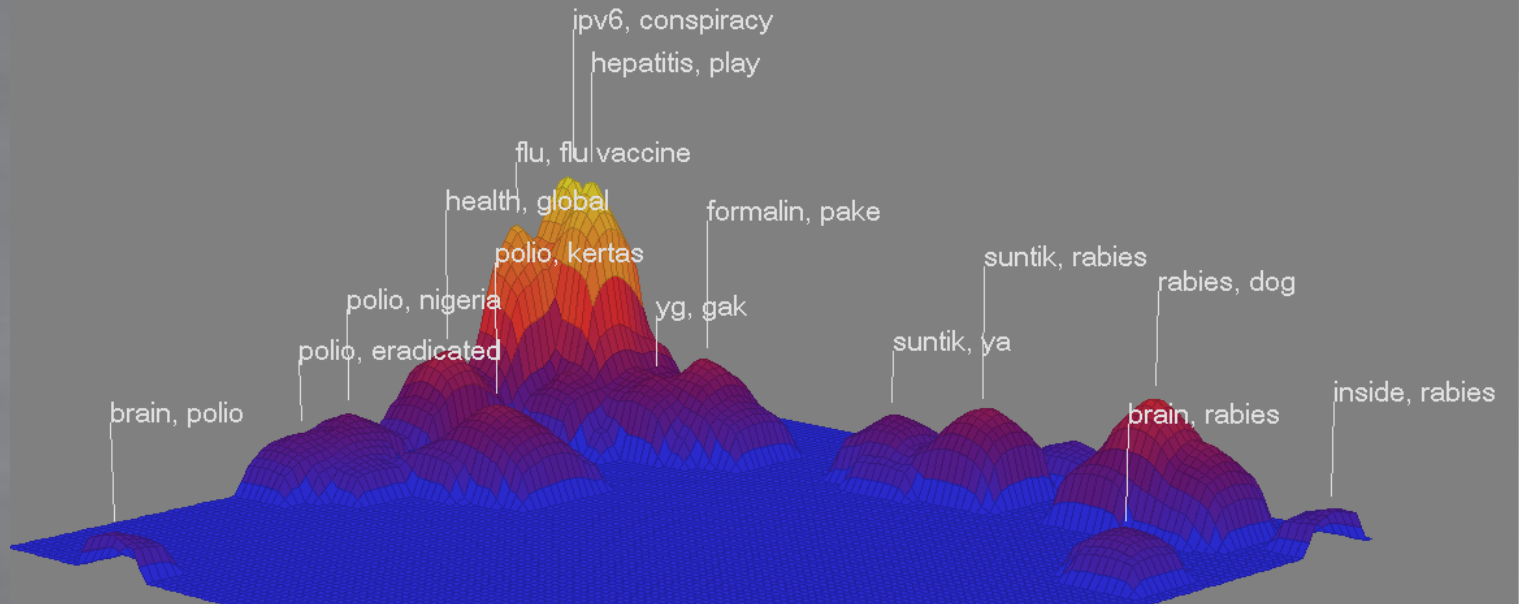
► Research Question:

- Can we analyze social media conversations in order to explore whether we can identify emerging concerns about vaccine safety in real time and then develop strategies to address those concerns.



Why Visual Analytics

- Identify related threads, intersections of topics
- Investigate backstory
- Quantify convergence of data on a particular topic or event
- Forecast and/or assess impact of events

Terminology (1)

▶ Theme

- A theme is a set of terms that typically occur within the same documents and a set of documents from which those terms have been extracted as keywords.

▶ Term and Key Term

- A term (in IN-SPIRE) can be a key term or a major term. A key term is a keyword (which may be a phrase) that has been identified as a representative keyword for some number of documents in the corpus.
- **On a short text corpus (such as tweets), the set of key terms is identical to the set of major terms.**
- If the corpus is not comprised of short text documents then another method is applied to select major terms. In that case a major term is an individual word or key term that is highly topical within the set of documents.

Terminology (2)

▶ Summary term

- A term that is highly associated with the current set of selected documents. This calculation is based on the similarity of the term's topical signature with the topical signature for the selected set of documents.

▶ Surprising term

- A term for which a high surprise score was calculated.

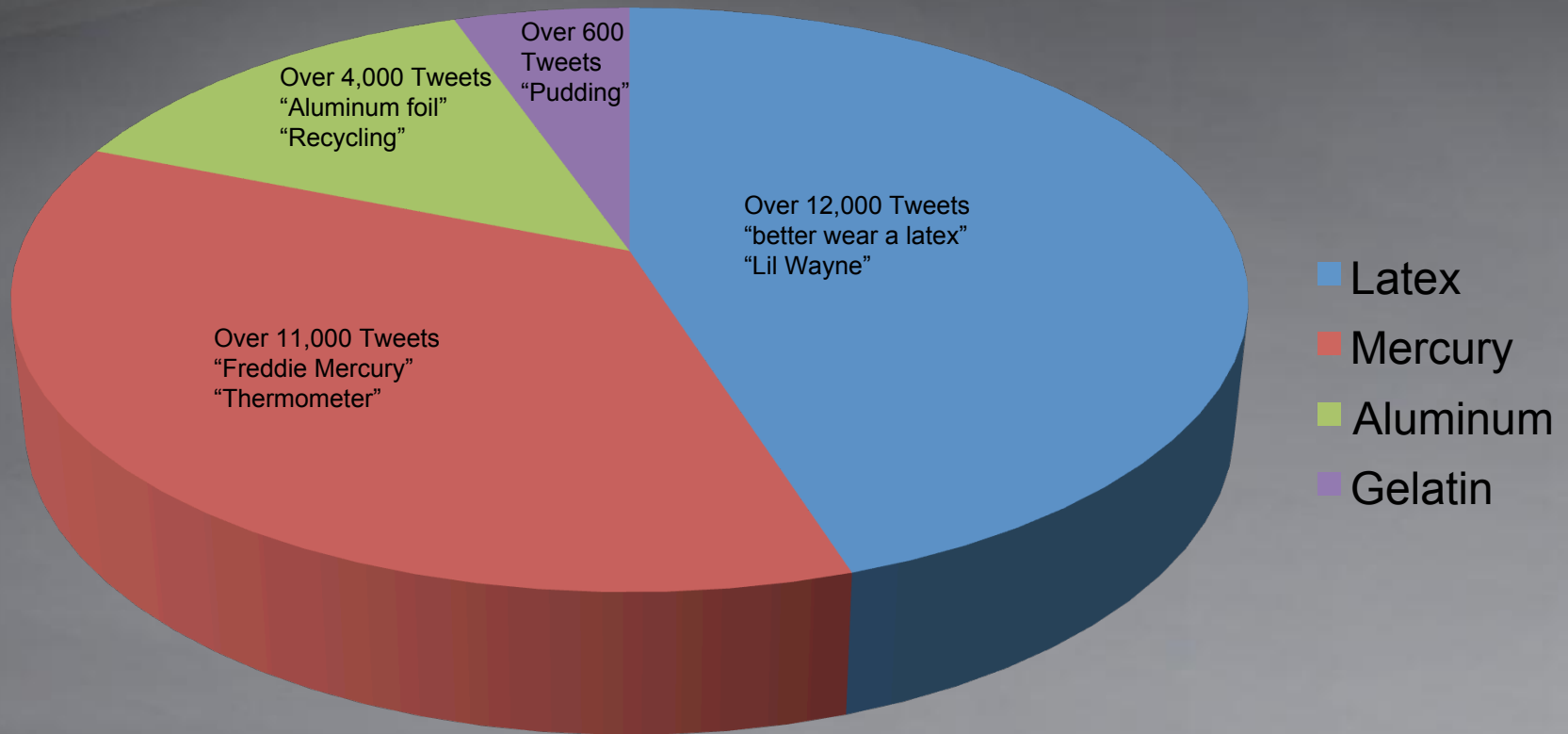
▶ Trending Topic

- In Twitter parlance, a word, phrase, or topic that is tagged more often than other tags. Trending topics become popular by users retweeting them. Basically these topics help the users understand what is happening in the world.
- In IN-SPIRE parlance, a trending topic displays throughout the timeline and has a tendency to continue on an incline. For example, if you select a top theme and open the Time tool, you will see the selection in green and how the theme is displayed over time.

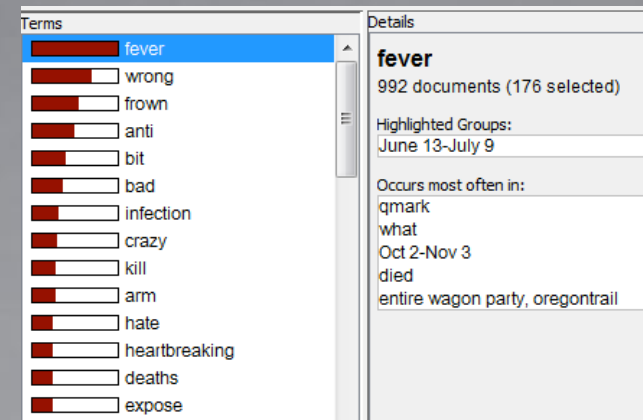
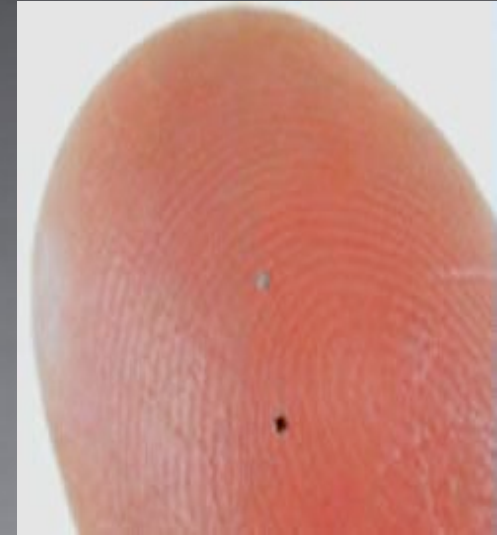
“Surprising” Vaccine Safety Tweets

- ▶ **Surprising tweets** are found utilizing a novel algorithm that leverages word co-occurrences, temporal trends, and other signatures
- ▶ Questions:
 - How do you all feel about the hpv vaccine? i was offered it today at the doctor but i'm unsure... #pleaserespond
 - Michele Bachmann says she 'heard of a woman who got mental retardation from the hpv vaccine.' it was her, right?
 - Cut my finger on a can. do i need a tetanus shot?
 - Will you give your son the hpv vaccine?
 - do you recommend any vaccinations ? /yes, but i think that the schedule needs to individualized and some vax aren't needed
- ▶ There is accurate information out there:
 - Why don' t we confront those parents who refuse to vaccinate their kids?

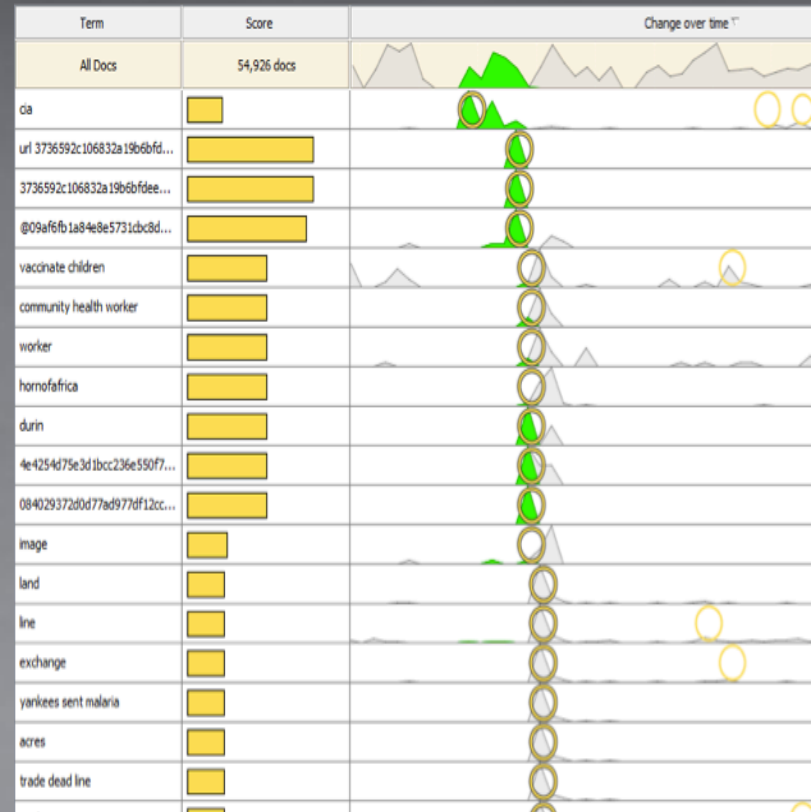

Scalable Reasoning System Overview

- ▶ Software framework for developing web-based analytic applications
- ▶ Connects to any data sources
- ▶ Analyzes and models data to produce visualizations
- ▶ Enables custom applications to be assembled and tailored for specific uses

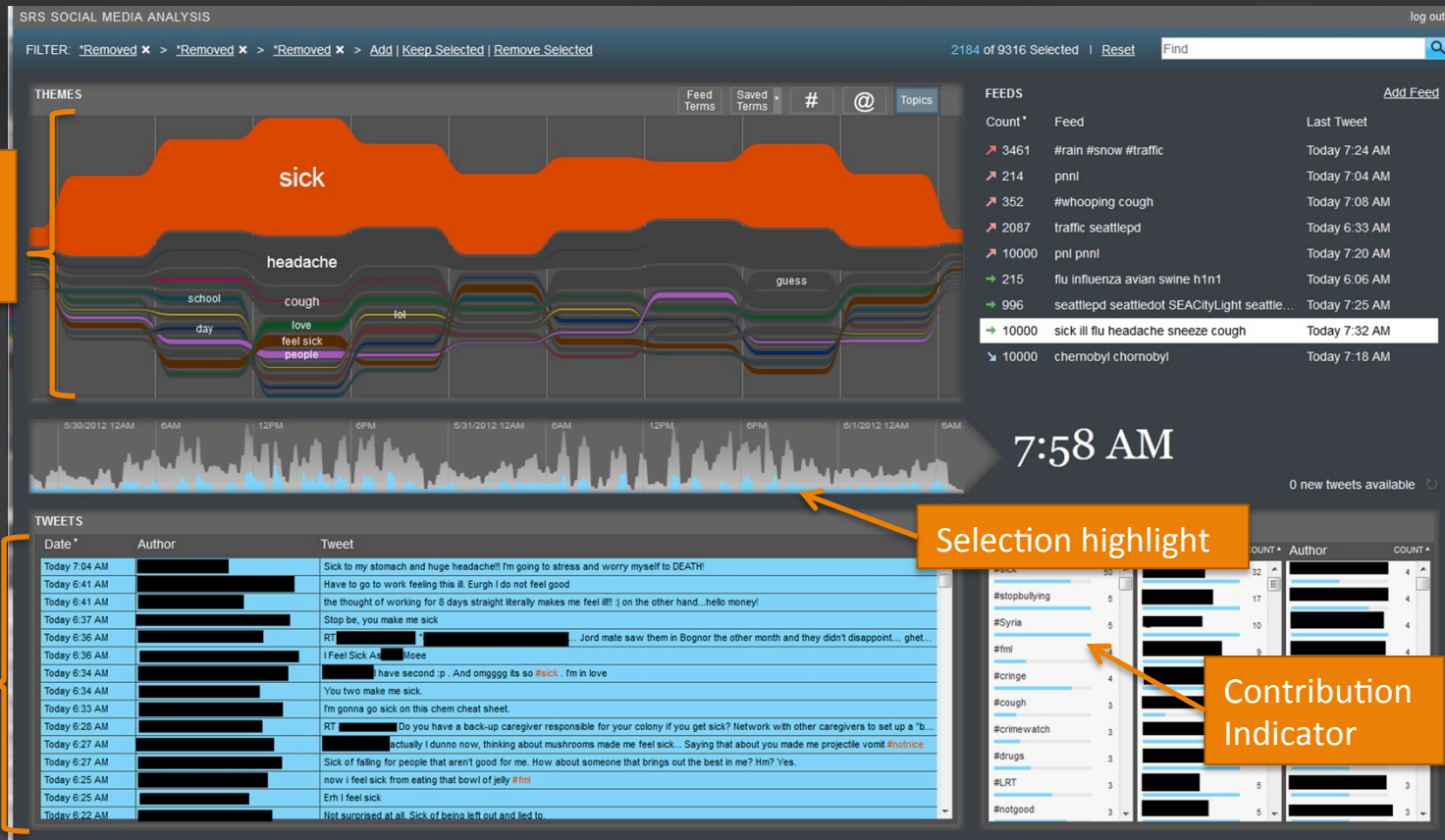

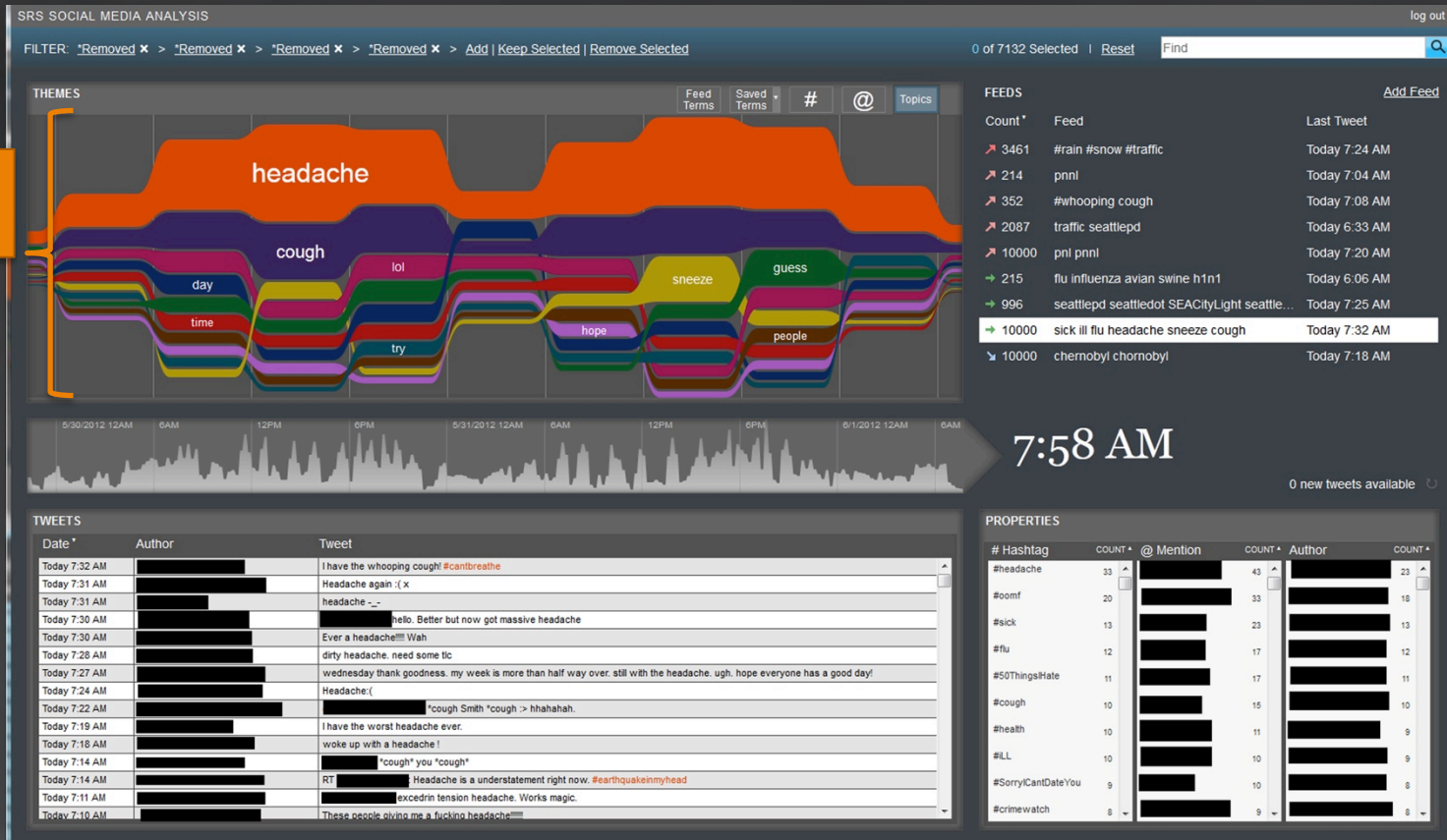
Twitter feed showing flu related tweets in the DC area with specific mention selected, showing brushing and linking
