

## **Acquired Syphilis v1** **Definition Factsheet & Technical Brief**

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**Definition Description:** Acquired syphilis is an infection caused by the bacterium *Treponema pallidum* that is most commonly transmitted via sexual contact. Syphilitic infections progress through multiple stages, alternating between symptomatic periods and periods of latency when no clinical signs or symptoms or infection are present. This definition was created by the CDC National Syndromic Surveillance Program (NSSP) for use with emergency department data to develop queries for acquired syphilis (i.e., non-congenital syphilis) in patients 10 years and older. Please note that the queries are developed using syphilis-related free text terms from chief complaint fields; International Classification of Diseases, Ninth Revision, Clinical Modification (ICD-9-CM) and Tenth Revision, Clinical Modification (ICD-10-CM) discharge diagnosis codes; and Systematized Nomenclature of Medicine Clinical Terms (SNOMED CT) as the basis for identifying patient visits of interest and not the Council of State and Territorial Epidemiologists (CSTE) syphilis surveillance case definition. The queried patient visits may or may not represent data for a case patient included in National Notifiable Diseases Surveillance System (NNDSS) case data and further public health investigation may be required. This query is intended to be a version 1 and may be further improved upon by the NSSP community of practice in the future. This query is intended to be narrow and capture visits with specific terms to support greater monitoring and actionable public health data. More complex and/or extensive queries may exist that more broadly capture symptoms or other terms.

### **Key Considerations**

These case definitions are intended for **surveillance and public health reporting** and may not fully align with clinical diagnosis or management or disease intervention practices. These definitions should not be utilized for meeting an individual patient's needs or for determining the specific partner services interventions that should be implemented.

Emergent Condition: Not Intended as Use Case

Justification: There is no current syndromic surveillance definition for acquired syphilis available in ESSENCE.

Data Source During Development: Emergency Department Visits. Chief Complaint Query Validation dataset (CCQV) in ESSENCE.

Validation Methods: This definition is part of the collection of definitions created by CDC NSSP for the rapid reportables project. The rapid reportables project is led by the CDC NSSP team to create definitions for all nationally notifiable diseases to be used when querying NSSP emergency department data. These definitions focus on chief complaint text and diagnostic codes of the disease or its causative agents with no mention of symptoms. Select members of the Community of Practice were then asked to review line-level results for their jurisdictions and provide feedback to ensure the intended results of the definitions were met.

Footnote:

- A visit is considered a true positive/probable if it contains chief complaint free text and a discharge diagnosis code of acquired syphilis in patients 10 years and older.
- A visit is considered undetermined if it contains a discharge diagnosis code for syphilis, but the chief complaint text does not indicate symptoms related to syphilis.
- A visit is considered a false positive/rule-out if it contains chief complaint text or discharge diagnosis codes for congenital syphilis.

Limitations:

Acquired syphilis is a particularly challenging infection to diagnose, and no studies have evaluated the validity of chief complaint data or ICD-9-CM, ICD-10-CM, or SNOMED CT codes for monitoring trends in acquired syphilis diagnoses. Due to a lack of widely available, reliable, cost-effective, and rapid direct detection testing options, syphilis diagnosis relies on a combination of serologic treponemal and nontreponemal test results. Accurate diagnosis requires correct interpretation of these serologic test results in the context of findings from the patient's history, physical examination, and past syphilis serologic test results (if available). However, signs and symptoms of primary or secondary syphilis are often subtle or may be confused with other conditions, and syphilitic lesions may occur at anatomic sites where they go undetected by patients and clinical providers. Additionally, because syphilitic infections often include prolonged periods of latency when no signs or symptoms are present, detection is frequently dependent on screening practices which may vary widely by facility or provider. Furthermore, depending on the patient's stage of infection, HIV status, and serologic response to therapy, up to 24 months of follow-up may be needed upon completion of stage-appropriate treatment. Consequently, syphilis diagnostic codes may inaccurately reflect a patient's stage of syphilitic infection, be utilized as justification for screening or

presumptive treatment, or indicate follow-up of a prior treated syphilitic infection. In light of these limitations, the acquired syphilis data gathered through the use of this definition may represent under- or overestimates of syphilis diagnoses, and these data should be interpreted with caution.

Definition Fields and Structure:

To ensure that only patients with acquired syphilis are captured, include an age restricting the dataset to patients ages 10 and over. This can be done by:

- Selecting the “Age Range” age group filter.
- Using the drop down box and selecting the operator “greater than or equal to”.
- Typing “10” into the input box for Age Range.

The Chief Complaint Discharge Diagnosis (CCDD) parsed field is used to query both the discharge diagnosis codes and chief complaint free text, and exclusions are incorporated as necessary.

#### Plain Language Description

The definition uses discharge diagnosis codes and free-text chief complaint terms. The definition requires that an emergency department visit contains a reference to the condition by its discharge diagnosis code (in at least one of the following: ICD-9-CM, ICD-10-CM, SNOMED CT diagnostic codes), or by the condition name listed in the chief complaint text. Therefore, the acquired syphilis v1 syndromic surveillance definition includes ICD-10-CM, and SNOMED CT diagnostic codes for acquired syphilis, along with direct mentions of acquired syphilis (including misspellings of syphilis) in chief complaint text. To ensure that only acquired syphilis was captured, we excluded records with chief complaint text and discharge diagnosis codes for congenital syphilis.

#### Suggested Use in Analysis

This definition combines all acquired syphilis infections, including acquired syphilis infections in women who are pregnant. To identify acquired syphilis in pregnant women, we suggest using ESSENCE fields like age group and CCDD category to identify these occurrences (details below).

#### **Acquired syphilis infections in pregnant women**

- Combine acquired syphilis definition **AND**
  - Age group  $\geq 10$  **AND**
  - CC and DD Category = “CDC Pregnancy and Pregnancy Loss and Delivery v1”
